Counterfeit pills are becoming more common in South Dakota. These fake pills have caused the number of **overdoses and deaths to skyrocket**, especially among young people age 15-24.

Fake pills can be easy to get on the street, and **buying drugs online, through social media, and payment apps** has become a popular new way for **drug dealers to target kids**.

Fake pills are often laced with lethal amounts of **FENTANYL**.

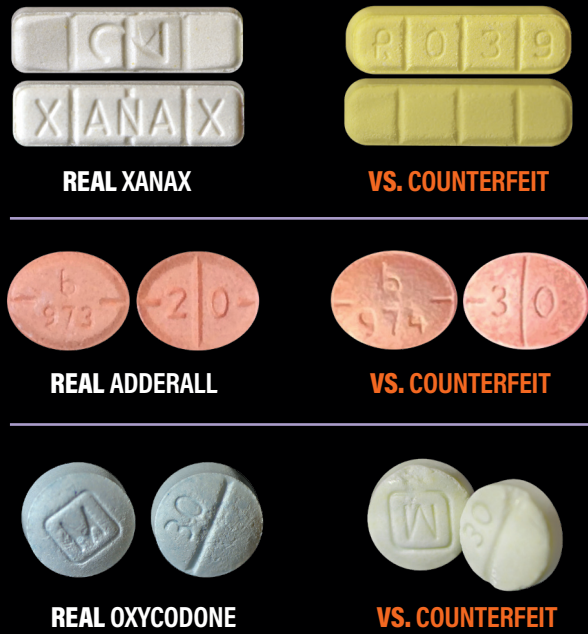
FENTANYL IS A SYNTHETIC OPIOID THAT IS UP TO

Common Counterfeits:



Many overdoses are linked to **illicitly manufactured fentanyl (IMF)** which is distributed through illegal drug markets. It is added to other drugs because of its extreme potency, which makes drugs cheaper, **more powerful, more addictive, and more dangerous**.

IMF can come in liquid or powder form. Powdered fentanyl looks just like many other drugs. It is commonly mixed with drugs like heroin, cocaine, and methamphetamine,

and made into pills that look like other prescription opioids. In liquid form, IMF can be found in nasal sprays, eye drops, and dropped onto paper or small candies.

Counterfeit drugs may contain deadly levels of fentanyl, and you aren't able to **see it, taste it, or smell it**.
